

Assistance: Arrival Assistance

Description: Meet your assistant at the arrival gate who will be holding a signboard with your name. Priority assistance through passport control/ security (if applicable) and to baggage claim. You will then be escorted directly to your private driver.





Accommodation: Pera Palace Hotel

Pera Palace Hotel is more than just one of Turkey's most elegant hotels; it is a historic monument that represents the character, style, and spirit of Istanbul. It held its opening ball in 1895, the clientele often arrived on the Orient Express train and, over the years, the hotel hosted such luminaries as Atatürk, Agatha Christie, Ernest Hemingway and Greta Garbo. Recently, it has undergone a full restoration and has re-opened its doors for you to experience the nostalgia of that glamorous era. The hotel overlooks the Golden Horn inlet of the Bosporus – a picturesque harbor that once sheltered Greek and Persian ships. Atatürk's favorite room – Room 101 – has been preserved in its vintage glory and features some of the famous man's own possessions. The Pera Palace Hotel is a place where East meets West and classic meets modern.





Private Tour with Car: Byzantine and Ottoman Marvels

Description: Your tour of the most renowned sites in Istanbul will start with the Hippodrome, which was one of the largest chariot race grounds of the Byzantine Empire. Explore the Blue Mosque within a complex that includes tombs, fountains, kitchens, and a bath. The blue Iznik Tiles covering the walls have given the mosque its popular name. You will also explore St. Sophia (the Church of Divine Wisdom) and one of the greatest marvels of architecture. This monument was constructed as a basilica in the 6th century by Emperor Justinian. Your adventure will then continue through the Grand Bazaar, the largest and oldest covered Bazaar in Turkey with more than 4,000 shops. A variety of handicrafts, carpets, rare jewels, and souvenirs are all sold in small shops next to each other, with merchants selling everything from antiques, homewares, books, copperware, ceramics, gold, and inexpensive trinkets. Venture into the hidden courtyards, and look out for marble fountains and ornate kiosks.



Private Tour with Car: Bodrum City Tour

Meeting Time: 9:00AM

Meeting Point: Swissotel Resort Bodrum Beach

Description: Explore the historic riches of Bodrum during this half-day tour accompanied by a private English-speaking guide. After meeting your guide at the hotel, you will start the tour with a visit to Bodrum Castle which occupies the tip of the wedge-like peninsula in the center of the city. It is a splendid example of medieval military architecture, built at a time when the European Middle Ages were over, and castles of this type were fast becoming objects of nostalgia. It has a massive conglomeration of courtyards, turrets, galleries, and sunken gardens. You will see the collections of the Museum of Underwater Archeology, located inside the Castle. The museum, the most important of its kind in the world, contains treasures from a series of historic wrecks discovered along Turkey's southern shores. Mycenaean and Canaanite artifacts recovered from an I2th century B.C. wreck found off Cape Gelidonya (Antalya) in 1960 formed the original core of the museum. On display in the castle's Gothic Chapel is a full-scale reconstruction of one-third of an Eastern Roman wreck from the 7th century A.D. You will also see the finds from the world's oldest known shipwreck, a 14th century B.C. vessel excavated off Uluburun (Kas). In the castle, you will also visit the Glasswreck Hall. During the summer of 1977, the Institute of Nautical Archaeology (INA) with the Bodrum Museum of Underwater Archaeology excavated a medieval shipwreck at Serce Limani, a natural harbor on the southern Turkish Coast. The ship had set sail in around 1025 A.D from the southern part of the Syrian coast then ruled by the Fatimid caliphs and was carrying a variety of cargoes, including 3 tons of glass cullet in the form of raw glass and broken glassware.
