





Athens Walking Discovery Tour

Your guided tour begins at the world-renowned Acropolis Museum, where nearly 4,000 artifacts are on display providing a detailed insight into the everyday life of Ancient Greece. There is also a magnificent view of the Acropolis from the museum's terrace. You will then head up to the top of the Acropolis hill via the gates of Propylaea, the monumental entrance to the Acropolis and an iconic example of classical antiquity, where you will discover the magnificence of the Parthenon and learn more on its impact on modern history. Finally, you will take a pleasant stroll through the narrow streets of Plaka, the city's historical neighborhood and visit to the Parliament Building in Syntagma Square, where you can watch the ceremonial changing of the guards at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

With a splendid view of the Saronic Gulf, you will be able to take in some of the most breathtaking Aegean blue scenery while passing local beaches and the famous Vouliagmeni Lake. Cape Sounion is the southernmost tip of the Attica peninsula and home to the world-renowned archaeological site of the Temple of Poseidon. Built between 444 and 440 BC, it is one of the major monuments of the Golden Age of Greece. Here you will be revel in spectacular views with a dramatic mountain backdrop.







Ancient Corinth Tour

★ Delphi Discovery

Immerse yourself in the myths and monuments of the Center of the Ancient world – Dephi. This UNESCO site was one of the most important religious and political sites in the times of Ancient Greece. Explore the Temple of Apollo, the site of the most famous ancient Greek oracle, and the ancient theater on the slopes of the mountain. Continue into the Archaeological Museum of Delphi, home to impressive votive offerings to Apollo, such as the magnificent bronze statue of the Charioteer of Delphi and the sculpture of Agias, an Ancient Greek Athlete. Following your visit, enjoy lunch at your leisure in the village of Delphi or Arahova along with stops for photos.


