



## Mykonos Island with Wine Tasting and Mezes Interests: wine, culture, foodie

There's nothing Greeks love more than good souvlaki and during your culinary famous adventure, you will learn how to make this Greek street food. Your experience starts with a private transfer from a central location to a private residence, located just 10 minutes from the Town of Mykonos. During our cooking class, you will have the opportunity to learn about the Mykonian culture, history, culinary traditions and festivals and also learn typical words used by the locals to describe their food while sipping a glass of Greek wine. Together with your chef and teacher you will marinate, assemble and grill the traditional pork or chicken skewers, make tzatziki, cut fresh vegetables to stuff your pita bread and wrap it. You can ask questions so you can recreate them all when you are back home. Once everything is cooked and flavors are soaked up, it's time to gather around the table with your handmade masterpieces, sharing feelings and laughter as Mykonians do.

## Komantic Ride at Dusk with Wine by the Seaside Interests: outdoor activities, foodie, wine

If you want to add a romantic bike tour to your Mykonos vacation, look no further. Soak in the sheer magnificence of the landscape that surrounds you while you pass the hills during a leisurely bike ride. Stop for a pre-prepared picnic at dusk and relax while you sip local organic wine and nibble on some traditional treats including Greek cheese & barley rusks, olives, dried fruits and nuts and the traditional almond sweet of Mykonos. ## Delos Island Extended Tour Interests: mythology, history, culture

The island of Delos, situated near Mykonos, is notorious as the mythical birthplace of the twin Gods, Apollo and Artemis. Rejoice, as you walk in the steps of Greece's illustrious ancestors, during your remarkable visit of the island. Your journey will begin at the pier in Mykonos town, with a short boat ride to Delos. Your private guide will give you a comprehensive tour of the island and its distinctive landmarks. Make sure not to miss the small sacred lake, now drained, and the ancient Agora, which was once a center of religious, political and commercial life. Your guide will share the insight into the importance of the Terrace of the Lions, an imposing series of lions, dedicated to Apollo, by the people of Naxos, shortly before 600 BC. The tour will continue to the ruined marble theater, which was built between 314 - 250 BC, and onto the Temple of the Delians, followed by several market squares, colossal statues and ancient living quarters.

There is no better way to explore the hidden bays, secluded beaches, and historic islands around Mykonos than on board a boat. Once you meet your boat captain and a stewardess, the captain will briefly go over your daily itinerary and start your nautical adventure. Depending on sea conditions, you will be able to explore the southern shores of Mykonos, including Dragonisi (Tragonisi). Accessible only by boat, Dragonisi or Tragonisi is an uninhabited private island a few miles southeast of Mykonos and has spectacular rock formations and caverns. It is a secluded refuge for monk seals and the area is under protection by the Natura 2000 project. Swim in the natural azure blue waters and enjoy the immaculate landscape, the serene atmosphere, and the feeling of being alone in the world. Alternatively, you can opt to visit Delos Island and the pristine Rhenia island right next to it. This historic island of Delos will take you back to the times of ancient Greece and its



myths. The name of the island is the antonym of "adelos" (invisible) in the ancient Greek language, and means "clear, brought to light, obvious or apparent". Deserted nowadays, this unique island is prominent due to the Greek myth that claims that it suddenly appeared amidst the waves of the sea, when Leto was looking for a safe place to give birth to Apollo and Artemis, the famous twin Olympian Gods. You will then continue your journey towards Rhenia Island, a secret paradise that is little-known, even to Greeks, and whose history is closely related to that of the well-known Delos Island. You will stop for swimming and snorkelling at one of its many beaches, all of which are unexpectedly beautiful and blessed with crystal-clear waters. No matter which side of the island you decide to explore on the day of the cruise, you will be amazed by the beauty and tranquillity that Mykonos has to offer.

Then, drive on a dirt road to reach a secluded beach which is known only to locals and which gives you an insight of what all the beaches in Mykonos looked like back in the 1960s. On the way there, you will see one of the two water dams built on the island in order to support the continuously increasing water needs.

Mykonos, the cosmopolitan jewel of the Aegean, gives you the authentic feeling of the Cyclades complete with whitewashed buildings, thin curvy paths, and spectacular beaches. Your guided tour of Mykonos, through the towns and beaches, will begin directly at your hotel or the port, as you absorb the history and customs of the locals, along a picturesque backdrop. Finally, you will embark on a walking tour of the Chora, the most populated part of the island. The charming center of town includes churches, restaurants, shopping, a bustling port, and very vibrant nightlife. Don't forget to check out the famous windmills and the island's mascot, Petro the Pelican!

You will have the opportunity to explore the area around Ano Mera renowned for its agriculture and the nearby old abandoned mine. After that, you will head to the windless beautiful beach Kalo Livadi, where you will have free time for lunch and swimming. As you start your journey back to Mykonos town, you will stop for one last highlight of your off-road adventure a photo opp at the old castle above the city.
