Dive to find its Hot Springs, have the chance to swim in the green sulfur waters, and experience bathing in warm therapeutic mud. Your next destination is the traditional island of Thirassia where you will have plenty of free time to explore sights such as the village of Manolas, which is accessed by winding stairs by either walking or riding a donkey. After you return to the boat the captain will make one last stop at the port of Armeni in Oia before sailing back to Athinios

You will be able to taste several varieties of wines produced on the island, including one of the most renowned ones – the sweet Vin Santo. Since no wine tasting would be complete without food, all the wines are expertly paired with meze style bites, making this tour a memorable experience for all your senses.

Santorini Caldera off the beaten track

Your knowledgeable local guide will take you on a journey back in time, filled with myths and legends, through a winding path with stunning panoramic views of Santorini and the deep blue horizon. Follow the footsteps of the affluent merchants of the island, feel the energy of the volcanic caldera and explore the backroads of Oia and Finikia. Discover and experience breathtaking villages through the eyes of a local. This walking tour will give you ample photo opportunities as well as an insight into Santorini's rich history



★ The Villages of Santorini Walking Tour

Experience the absolute splendor of Santorini while strolling through some of the most scenic and quiet villages of the island. Walk from Pyrgos to Megalohori alongside beautiful mansions, explore quaint rural houses and discover the charm of Santorini's abandoned neighbourhoods. On your tour, you will also get to visit a family-owned winery to taste award winning local volcanic wines. A visit to Symposion by Laponta can be arranged as an alternative for anyone who does not want to visit a winery. Your local guide will take you to the countryside where you will get to mingle with locals still living there and learn about professions and crafts that no longer exist. Discover cave houses and capture the essence of Santorini as it used to be, before being wrecked by a massive earthquake. Enjoy a trip back in time and let the aura of Santorini's authentic villages enhance your senses. 4km.

Akrotiri and Emporio Village Tour

Interests: history, culture, architecture

Enjoy the day with your private driver and guide as you explore the spectacular island of Santorini. You will start your tour by heading to the Minoan Bronze Age settlement of Akrotiri on the southern part of the island and which has a great number of remarkably well-preserved remains of vibrant Frescoes and artifacts. From there, we will head to Emporio, the largest village in Santorini, and which once was the center of the commercial affairs on the island. Nowadays, the village is a peaceful settlement with beautiful houses and yards, many of which have been renovated, making the place very attractive. You can find plenty of shops, cafes, bars and traditional taverns along with admirable, blue-domed churches and tiny chapels. The main attraction of Emporio is the medieval Kasteli, one of the five fortified castles of Santorini. Inside the castle there is a church that dates back to the 16th century.

Akrotiri Archaeological Tour

Interests: archeology, history, outdoor activities

Enjoy the day with your private driver and guide as you explore the history of Santorini. The focal point of your tour will be the Minoan Bronze Age settlement of Akrotiri or the 'Greek Pompeii', located on the southern part of the island. In prehistory, Akrotiri was a well-connected Minoan port town, with connections to mainland Greece and as far afield as Egypt and Syria. As the town was covered in ash following a volcanic eruption on the island, preservation of the settlement is exceptional, making this one of the most significant archaeological sites in Greece. Today the site is covered by a bioclimatic roof and walkways are suspended above the archaeological remains, allowing visitors to walk among the two and three-story buildings.



Caldera Steps at Santorini Village (Imerovigli-Firostefani Blue Dome-Oia) Interests: outdoor activities, architecture, history

The astounding view from Imerovigli Village is a memory that you will treasure for a lifetime. In this tour, you will admire the famous Blue Dome of Firostefani, take photos of the amazing Caldera landscapes at the most famous village of Santorini, the village of Oia, while walking by the alleys of the village and later watching the most beautiful sunset of Greece.
