Your tour will start with a panoramic drive through Naples which will help you unveil the hidden treasure of this lovely City. You will revel in the view of the Royal Palace which acted as the seat of the Bourbon Kings until 1861, the Galleria, an elegant meeting point and shopping center, and continue on through Via Caracciolo, the lovely promenade that stretches along the Bay of Naples. Visit the Archaeological Museum and discover its vast collection of artifacts from various historical periods with a special accent on the stunning pieces found during the excavations of Pompei, Herculaneum and Stabiae, the three roman cities that vanished under the ashes after the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD. After your museum tour, your guide will be able to suggest a great venue for lunch should you decide to refresh and recharge your batteries with some authentic Italian delicacies.

Pompeii & Vesuvius Tour from Naples Interests: history, archaeology, architecture, nature

Start your journey with a visit to the UNESCO's World Heritage Site, Pompeii. When Mt Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD, Pompeii was buried under lava and ash and lay forgotten for hundreds of years. Explore the ancient city covered by volcanic dust and discover the excavated remains of the Forum, Thermal Baths, Lupanare and Vetti's House with its beautiful frescos. Next, you will go to Mount Vesuvius, the only active volcano in continental Europe. You will have the opportunity to climb the mountain (approximately 45 minutes), accompanied by your guide, and walk around the crater at an elevation of 3,900 feet. Once you reach the summit you'll get to bask in the panoramic views of the picturesque Bay of Naples from east to west.

Pompeii & Herculaneum Tour from Naples Interests: history, archaeology, architecture, nature

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Pompeii is one of the most renowned attractions in Italy, drawing travelers from across the world each year to explore its ruins. When Mt Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD, Pompeii was buried under lava, ash, and pumice and completely forgotten for more than a thousand years. Explore the ancient city covered by volcanic dust and discover the excavated remains of the Forum, Thermal Baths, Lupanare and Vetti's House with its beautiful frescos. Your next stop will be Herculaneum. Once a thriving ancient residential town filled with villas of wealthy Romans, Herculaneum has been preserved like no other site in the world. The city was buried beneath 16 meters of ash and mud during the eruption, and this layer of soft tufa - a type of course rock, saved two-story Domus homes with the internal architecture and décor intact, including features in wood and marble, decorations, jewelry, and even organic remains like food, providing a unique view into the daily lives during Ancient Rome.

✗ Capri Island Tour

Explore the gem of the Mediterranean sea, the island of Capri with its breathtaking landscapes sculpted by wind and sea, its history, and exclusive atmosphere. Meet your guide and board the fast jetfoil to Capri. Once on Capri, you will board the minibus for a shared island tour. You will reach Anacapri, the town on the top of the Island where you will have time at your disposal to enjoy the shops or to climb to Monte Solaro by chair-lift. After lunch, the tour will then continue to Capri town. Here you will enjoy a walk to the Gardens of Augustus with a stunning view over the southern side of Capri. Return to Capri pier and board the jetfoil to Naples.
