

Dine in Lisbon 2023

Michelin Star:

- <u>Belcanto</u> Distinguished with two Michelin stars, Belcanto restaurant opened in 1958, in Chiado. At Belcanto, José Avillez invites us on an incomparable gastronomic and sensory journey where he offers a revisited Portuguese cuisine to an exclusive set of ten tables in a sophisticated atmosphere.
- <u>Feitoria</u> Feitoria is a signature cuisine restaurant, with one Michelin star, where traditional flavours and the best national products predominate and mould around contemporary tastes.
- <u>Eleven</u> The restaurant is located in the heart of Lisbon's business district, overlooking the entire city and surrounded by lush gardens. More than simply a restaurant, Eleven is a place of culture and art, both at the table and beyond it, awarded with a Michelin Star.
- Alma Awarded with 1 Michelin Star, ALMA is defined as a fine dining restaurant: author's cuisine, served informally in a sophisticated setting. It aims to be an innovative space, not only with regards to the approach it proposes, but also to simplify and break down some basic rules of the service, which is rigorous but relaxed.

Fine Dining:

- MINIBAR from José Avillez This is a different and exquisite restaurant, inside a theatre.
 The ambiance is sophisticated and the menu is created to dazzle its guests and serve a very unique meal.
- <u>Tágide</u> For the past thirty years, the Tágide restaurant has remained one of Lisbon's most prestigious restaurants. Occupying a fine 18th-century building, this flagship restaurant is situated in the heart of Chiado and boasts one of the most amazing views over the old quarter of the city and Tagus river. It serves delicious Portuguese based "cuisine" with international influences in a classic and unique environment.
- Bistro 100 Maneiras In an Art Deco-inspired building that has been restored to become a timeless house, which extends over two floors (one for smokers, one smoke-free), the 100 Maneiras Bistro is open since 2014 with room for up to 80 guests, open until 2am in the morning, everyday.

Casual Dining:

- <u>Sea Me Peixaria</u> Moderna This restaurant is located in Chiado, close to the Luis de Camões Square, and is a trendy gastronomic space serving mostly seafood, in homage to the sea heritage of Portugal.
- <u>A Travessa</u> A refined yet informal environment that plays host to a cuisine of international recognition, in a harmonious fusion with traditional Portuguese gastronomy.

• Pateo - Bairro do Avillez "Bairro do Avillez", José Avillez's new restaurant, is located in Chiado. A wonderful Taberna for those who like amazing food; and the most spectacular Pateo in town, where seafood and fish are kings a live alongside the fun cotton candy.
