

Day 2 Private Athens Walking Discovery



Your guided tour begins at the world-renowned Acropolis Museum, where nearly 4,000 artifacts are on display providing a detailed insight into the everyday life of Ancient Greece. There is also a magnificent view of the Acropolis from the museum's terrace. You will then head up to the top of the Acropolis hill via the gates of Propylaea, the monumental entrance to the Acropolis and an iconic example of classical antiquity, where you will discover the magnificence of the Parthenon and learn more on its impact on modern history.

Finally, you will take a pleasant stroll through the narrow streets of Plaka, the city's historical neighborhood and visit to the Parliament Building in Syntagma Square, where you can watch the ceremonial changing of the guards at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

PLEASE NOTE: Optional taxi/subway services can be incorporated between locations. However, as this is a walking tour, these transportation costs are not included. Nor are meals and refreshments.


Day 3 Private Argolis Discovery



Your tour starts with a scenic drive along the coastal road along the Saronic Gulf towards your first stop, the Corinth canal. The famous narrow waterway that separates mainland Greece from the Peloponnese will provide you with the first of many perfect photo opportunities of the day. Crossing into the Peloponnese you enter Argolida, the land of Homer's Golden Mycenae and home to King Agamemnon. Your walking tour of this stunning UNESCO site commences by entering through the Lion's Gate, erected during the 13th century BC and the only remaining monumental piece of Mycenaean sculpture. Explore the awe-inspiring examples of Cyclopean masonry found in the walls of Mycenae and continue with a visit to the Royal Tombs of King Agamemnon and his wife Clytemnestra along with the Treasury of Areus.

From here, you will travel to the Great Theater of Epidaurus, known for its perfect acoustics. Built in 340 BC, it is so well-preserved that it is still used today for dramatic theatrical performances and concerts. At the end of your tour, you will be dropped off at your hotel in Monemvasia.

Day 4
Private Monemyasia Castle Tour



Embark on a 2-hour walking tour of Monemvasia during which you will discover the Upper and Lower old town, accompanied by a local guide. Wander through the picturesque and winding narrow streets, explore the fortress walls, and the churches in order to step back in time and imagine the life of this mythical castle town through the centuries. Gazing at Myrtoo Sea below the imposing rock, relive the stories and the legends, listen to poems written about Monemvasia and learn more about the local history, architecture and culture.

Day 6
Private Mystras and Olive Oil Museum in Sparta




Starting from Monemvasia, you will go to the town of Mystras, where your exploration truly begins. Sitting on the steep slopes of the Taygetus Mountains and surrounded by ancient walls, this former Byzantine capital is where the last Byzantine emperor was crowned. Explore Byzantine churches (the oldest dating back to 1270) and learn about the wall paintings and the floor mosaics, Frankish & Ottoman monuments, and several foundations of houses and palace ruins where the nobles lived. Continuing with your trip, visiting the city of Heroes, Sparta. Visit the Olive Oil Museum, learn about its production from prehistoric times to the early 20th century, and its significance throughout history.

At the end of your tour, you will be dropped off at Euphoria Retreat.

Day 7 Private Hiking in Gialova and Paleocastro



Following the path around the Gialova lagoon, you will have the opportunity to observe its ecosystem and receive knowledge and information about this unique and sensitive natural environment. Along the way cross the beautiful beach of Voidokoilia and then go up the hill of the peninsula of Koryfasio. You will get the chance to explore the cave of Nestor, the mythical king of Pylos. At the top of the hill, you will discover the medieval castle of Paleocastro and walk over its fortifications. Marvel at the panoramic view of the Ionian Sea, the lagoon of Gialova, the beach of Voidokilia and the bay of Navarino.

Please Note: You should wear comfortable sport shoes, hat, sunscreen and sunglasses.

Private Ancient Nemea and Nafplion Discovery




If you are a true oenophile, Peloponnese is a region filled with excellent wineries, especially around Nemea, one of the largest and richest wine-producing areas in Greece. During this tour, you will see how Nemea is divided into three sub-zones, classified by altitude. You will visit three wineries to try the trademark wine of the area, the ancient Agiorgitko, and other Greek wines produced. This tour aims to give insight into the culture of wine and winemaking through the unique flavors of indigenous Greek grape varieties. At the last winery, you will enrich the wine tasting experience with a delicious meal full of traditional flavors and locally grown products and herbs. Transfer back to the hotel after lunch and last winetasting session.
